Follow-up on Math Assessment discussion

Mrs. Korzick talked about the Math Festival and the student body and parent response to it. A total of approximately 70 families showed up, it was a great turnout. There was low attendance from the older kids – 4th and 5th graders- probably due to too much homework. There was great attendance from the primary grades. There were also other activities going on that evening – Reflections and Church- and we still had a good turnout at the festival. Furthermore, it is in the higher grades (4th and 5th grades) that our Math scores are suffering.

We discussed creating crates with the worksheets used in the Math festival for all the grades throughout the school. We would need to do 6 crates with sheet protectors for the worksheets, file folders sorted and organized. This solution will give the teachers more time to dedicate to Math. The funds for this project will come from the “Teacher Appreciation Day” budget. However, we need to know what is the total amount needed to complete this project.

In the December meeting we talked about how Greenbrook has hired a teacher dedicated to Math intervention for the 4th and 5th grades. Apparently, this teacher takes the lower students and works with them. Julie Olimpia is waiting to hear more about this teacher at Greenbrook.

Action: Mrs. Korzick will get a quote of the cost. Once we get the quote we will set up a committee to make all the crates.

Budget Review

Found that the amount for books other than texts is \$500, we will give this amount to Mrs. Miller. A tentative \$2400 was raised last year at the auction with the “Fund-a-need”. Mrs. Miller requested \$3000 in the Site Plan.

The amount allocated for conferences this year is \$2000. Mrs. Utley and Mrs. Cox may be using this to attend a conference.

We are \$9000 short for substitutes and our bottom line is \$8824.
